## **Daily Student Requirements:**

- At least 1 hour of work per subject (approximately 4 hours per day)
- Log in to Google Meet check-ins
- Stay on pace with workload (falling behind pace can lead to being dropped from the program)

## **Parent/Guardian Responsibilities:**

- Make sure students are meeting their requirements
- Communicate with teacher in a timely manner
- Monitor students progress, work completion, work quality, etc.
- You are their support provider, just like a classroom teacher.

Please let me know how I can support you.

- -Check all work for completion before submitting.
  - Did you read all the directions?
  - Did you complete all the steps?
  - Did you go over the checklist or read it aloud before you turned it in?
  - Punctuation/capitalization
  - Check Spelling
  - Check Grammar/sentence structure
  - Is it in the correct format?
- -Paragraphs need a topic sentence, details, and a concluding sentence.
- -Essays need an introduction with a thesis statement, body paragraphs, and a conclusion that addresses the thesis. .
- -Read Daily for **20 minutes** (either assigned or student choice)
- -Complete the Monthly book log in Google Classroom to record nightly reading.
- -Stay on pace! It is important to not get too behind, or too ahead. If you fall behind, it is overwhelming to catch up. If you get too far ahead, your child is likely not mastering the skills being taught.
